Our Taste Fest was a huge success. Our profit will be somewhere between \$16,000.00 and \$17,000.00. Thanks to everyone who helped make the evening great.

There will be a family information meeting at 6:30 today in the cafeteria for any parent/girl interested in having a Brownie/Girl Scout troop here at St. Ed's.

This year, 2019, is the 60th anniversary of St. Edward on-the-Lake Catholic School. So on December 5th, which is the 60th day of school in our 60th year, we will be having a celebration. We will have an assembly for the children (parents will be invited also), a special lunch, and classroom activities throughout the day. Father Acervo will lead the children in the Living Rosary. We are also having a t-shirt designed for this special occasion. The cost of the shirts will \$7.00, I will send more information later.

The Enchanted Princess Ball is coming back to St. Edward on-the-Lake. The dates for the Ball are Saturday, December 14th and Sunday, December 15th. I don't know the times of the performances as yet. As soon as I get more information I will let you know.

Here at St. Ed's the children do not wear costumes or have parties on Halloween, Oct. 31st.
