My Dear Parents,

We are trying a couple of new things next week for lunches. On Tuesday, Hungry Howies pizza will be served. The cost is \$1.00 per slice. The money needs to be brought in on by Tuesday morning so we know how much pizza to order. If your child doesn't order pizza, they should bring a cold lunch. Thursday, Nov. 21st, is a Jersey Mike's day. Envelopes are attached to the Laker if you wish to order a sub from Jersey Mikes. Each child needs their own envelope so the correct order can get to each student. Neither the cost of the pizza nor Jersey Mikes can be charged to a student's lunch account.

There will be no school on Friday, November 15th. The school office will be closed, also. Tuesday's conferences are being rescheduled for next Tuesday, November 19th during the same times.

On Thursday, December 5th, which is the 60th day of the school year, we will be celebrating the 60 year anniversary of our school. The day will begin with an All-School Mass.
